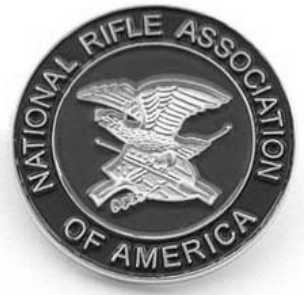

DUES INCREASE ... You should have received your Dues Notice for 2015, and yes the dues have been increased to \$240 per year (up from \$180 last year).

Your dues are used by the Club to pay for all of the overhead costs incurred by the Club; which include general liability insurance, liquor liability insurance, building fire and casualty insurance, electricity service, telephone service, cable TV service, garbage service, propane service, bookkeeping and accounting services, health insurance for our two managers, major equipment repairs and replacement, property taxes, land purchase payments, etc.

As you know, these costs for the Club continue to increase every year just like they do for us at home and drive our dues higher.

The additional funds generated by this dues increase will be used to: Pay for increased overhead costs as noted above, necessary to keep the club open; Perform necessary building repairs that have been deferred due to lack of funds; Pay off the \$65k outstanding balance for the club's 13 acre property addition; Upgrade the building electrical and plumbing which is grossly inadequate; Purchase replacement equipment as older equipment fails; Fund additional stages of the bar and clubhouse remodel; Build an additional reserve to make possible another 5 acre property purchase to increase the margin of safety on our shooting ranges.
