INITIATIVE 594: ... To Our Members: As the November election approaches we encourage you to please read the text of I-594 very carefully as it may sound good at the outset but is a very restrictive measure that seriously limits transfers of guns between private parties, including family members. It is a measure full of flaws and overreach. We encourage a <u>NO</u> vote on 594. A lot of BIG money from liberal out-of-state interests (like Bloomberg) are supporting this gun-control measure. The other firearms initiative, I -591, is a practical and protective measure that requires Washington lawmakers pass no legislation that is more restrictive than the federal laws. It is a grassroots effort with donations from little guys like us that support our constitution. We encourage your yes vote on I-591. FYI: I-591 is supported by WACOPS the Washington Council of Police and Sheriffs, representing over 4500 active duty officers & deputies among other LE organizations, having done the critical analysis of each initiative measure, oppose I-594 and fully support I-591.
