<u>COHO SALMON DERBY</u> ... The Sebo's Whidbey Island Coho Derby will be held on Saturday September13, 2014. "Weigh In" will be at the Holmes Harbor Rod & Gun Club from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The awards ceremony will be held at 4:30 PM at the Holmes Harbor Rod & Gun Club. Participants must be present at awards ceremony to win a prize. Food and beverages will be available for purchase starting at noon.
