From The Loading Bench

Hello all,

It's a new year. And, as is mentioned elsewhere in the Target, we have a substantially new Board. If you get a chance, please welcome and thank the new members, and also thank the outgoing members for their service - Michael McInerney, John Dorsh, and Dave Shupe.

The Spotlight is the regular feature of the Target where we usually send out thanks to individuals for stepping up and helping out the club, but I wanted to do a little additional thanks. While having dinner at the club over the Holidays, it suddenly struck me how great the clubhouse looked in its winter/Christmas garb. I've mentioned here before, and as a Board member have often discussed the trend to declining volunteerism, but there I sat surrounded by lovely decoration that took a huge number of hours. Embarrassingly, I did not know who did all that work. But I asked - and for the Christmas season, and all the other seasonal decorations they do during the year, I hope they won't mind too much if I shine a little additional spotlight on Frannie Johnson and her posse - Bruce Allan, Jim Balkowitsch, Joan Blasko, Betty Galbreath, Emily McArthur, and Weezie Grubb.

We have a new heating system! The install, wiring, and turn-on of three new heat pumps occurred over the last few weeks. The total cost of the installed system was \$13,900, but our cost was \$8,400, as we received a rebate from PSE and matching funds from Community Energy Challenge. These great programs offset an obviously large percentage of the cost, and will bring the return on this investment via energy savings in much sooner. Island Ductless did nice work on the install, and helped coordinate with PSE and Sustainable Connections for the rebates. The heat pumps also provide cooling, so we can look forward to more comfortable summers as well.

Some numbers: Last year the club spent \$307,797 against a budget of \$313,750. The largest non-reoccurring expenses were the bar remodel and the heat pump installation, the latter being unplanned. We added to the operational reserve, but not as much as we had hoped for in our five year plan. The Board has passed a budget for 2016 of \$278,476 based on the assumption of income from 750 paid members. This is a smaller budget than last year, and we are hoping it is conservative and we can continue adding to the reserves. The only large non-reoccurring expense planned for this year is the replacement of the (inefficient and failing) electric water heaters that service the kitchen.
