#### Shotgun Ranges -

Thursdays

Trap and Skeet starting at noon (except for Thanksgiving)

Sundays

Trap, Skeet, and Sporting Clays starting at noon

#### Range Safety Class -

First Tuesday of the month at 7PM

(Call, email, or watch the weekly updates for additional range training events.)

#### Range Hours -

9AM to Dusk (Please remember with the Fall time change, sunset in November is about 4:30PM)

#### NRA Memberships -

HHR&G is an authorized NRA Recruiter – You may join the NRA or renew your existing NRA membership via our website. There have been some cases of people damaging the ranges. Everyone should endeavor to leave the ranges in better shape than they found them.

Please remember to place targets such that the frames and stands are not damaged during shooting.

Clear away used targets and remove any spent shell casings. There are trash dumpsters and "brass buckets" for your convenience.

Members are required to take our Range Orientation & Safety Class before using the shooting facilities.

Membership cards with attached range stickers are to be visibly worn while using the club's ranges.

The range safety classes are

held the first Tuesday of the month at 7PM. Additional classes are scheduled as needed. All classes are open to the public and we encourage you to invite your family and friends.
