

Summary Financial Report for 2017

The club finished the year with strong membership numbers

- 944 members
- Our strong membership ensures a strong financial position
- Membership dues are they are our primary source of income

Below is a summary of some of the important financials for the club in 2017

- Budgeted income for 2017 was \$220,976
- Actual income for 2017 was \$231,202
- Actual expenditures for 2017 were in line with the budgeted amounts. Here is a summary of major items:
 - \$162,625 for mandatory spending (overhead items to keep the doors open). Mandatory spending include a range of things such as Security & Alarms, Utilities, Taxes, Accounting, Insurance, Water Testing, Salaries, Land Payments, etc.
 - \$68,625 for Maintenance, Repairs, and Club Improvements:
 - Approx. \$31,000 was spent on the purchase and Installation of a backup generator to allow the club to remain open during power outages -- \$25000 of which was from donations made to the club and earmarked for this project. The balance came from the general fund.
 - Additional items:
 - · New security cameras
 - New sound system
 - Paving of the road to the speed bays
 - Removal of the old trailer form the property
 - New ice machine in bar
 - New floor and sub-floor in the bar storage room
 - Water piping repairs
 - Electrical system repairs and improvements
 - Attic insulation
 - · Fridge and freezer repairs and replacements
 - Lawn mowing equipment
 - Topsoil and grass
