Please Remember:



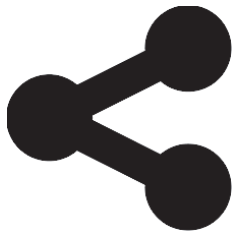
The Board has established a policy in compliance with WA State Liquor Control Board regulations – which prohibit serving individuals under the age of 21, those who are intoxicated, or those who show signs of intoxication.



Members and guests will respond politely and accurately when asked for proof of membership, authorization of range usage, or questions regarding use of the Club's property.



No one shall reprimand fellow members or staff and they will refrain from harassment (sexual or otherwise), discrimination, swearing, screaming, menacing, physically threatening, or aggressive behavior toward others.



Everyone will exercise good judgment and consideration for others by not monopolizing limited staff, ranges, and other Club resources.



Children are welcome; however, they must be accompanied **and supervised** by a parent or responsible guardian at least 18 years of age.



Maintain a respectful and courteous decorum while at the Holmes Harbor Rod and Gun Club and Club sponsored events.



Always use careful and considerate attention when driving and parking.



Always exercise appropriate safety, courtesies, kindnesses, and patience.



Pets must be cleaned up after, supervised, and controlled at all times while on the Club premises.
